

29th St. Augustine Lions Seafood Festival – March 12th-14th (check in is Friday 10-2pm)

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Information: Visitor websites are www.oldcity.com , www.staugustine.com , www.staugustinechamber.com , www.visitstaugustine.com or www.visitoldcity.com . Make your hotel or camping reservations before arriving. We have parking for cars, trucks and RV units shorter than 26 ft. See your acceptance notice for hotel and camping information. We do NOT allow resale, imported, flea market or buy/sell items. If you are not sure about an item, call or email for clarification. No refunds for acts of GOD. You must obey Florida sales Tax regulations.

Directions: 29 W. Castillo Drive, St Augustine, FL 32084. This street runs from U.S.1 (Ponce De Leon Blvd) to San Marco Ave (AIA). It is located next to the Visitors Information Center. Landmarks to the west are Prosperity Bank and Village Inn and to the east Ripley's Believe It or Not. When travelling to area by I-95 do not get off at Highway U.S. 1 exits. Instead exit onto State Rd. 16 or State Rd. 207. Travel to Highway U.S.1 (Ponce de Leon blvd). From State Rd. 16 turn south (right) on Ponce De Leon blvd. From State Rd. 207 turn north (left) on Ponce De Leon Blvd. It is then less than 2 miles to the traffic light at Castillo and Ponce De Leon Blvd. Castillo Dr. is a divided street and you can not turn on to field coming from the east.

Check in: Friday you may get in line at 10:00 AM. Proceed to Welcoming Area. You will be checked in and receive your site number and parking permit. Wear a nametag so that our staff and vendors can identify you. Be prepared to produce a photo id at check in.

At your site 1.UNLOAD 2. MOVE VEHICLE OFF FIELD 3. RETURN TO SETUP

Exhibitor hours: The show opens at 3:00 PM Friday. Friday is a slower day but the crowds come out on the weekend. Exhibitors must be open Friday 3:00 – Sundown, Saturday 10:00 – Sundown and Sunday 10:00-5:00. We will have dining and music until 9:00 PM on Friday and Saturday.

Police security is provided at night and most daytime hours.

Vendor parking: is south of the field, next to the large 2 story brick building, behind the tennis courts and the playground area. You will have to go completely around the block to enter and exit on Cordova St. The gate is on the eastside behind the field and playground. Close the gates!

There are 2 pedestrian gates for you to enter and exit the field. One is between the playground and tennis courts; and the other is at the far corner of the tennis courts.

Place your parking permit in your window; instructions are on the back of the parking permit.

Food: You may go to the side of the food vendor's booths and identify yourself for faster service. You need to purchase tokens to buy food.

Restrooms: other than Portolets are on the north side in the small building.

Utilities: If you paid for electricity you must provide an extension cord; if you requested water you must provide a water hose. You may be as much as 50 feet away from the electric or water outlet so judge the length of cord or hose that you might need. You will be sharing, so a junction or splitter will be useful.

Break Down: On Sunday: NO vehicles allowed on the field until 5:30PM (we must safely clear area). You may pack up from 5:00 till 5:30. You must clean up your space when leaving. That means "TAKE YOUR TRASH TO THE DUMPSTER. Do not use the garbage cans. Do not leave zip ties, string or other debris.
